# Competence-Oriented Guiding and Efficiently Organising Office Hours

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### THE WORKSHOP

This student-centred and competence-oriented guiding is fundamental to successful learning processes. In this workshop, we will reflect on

- the lecturer's different guiding roles
- how to guide students in the context of student-centred and competence-oriented learning
- how to structure the guiding process
- how to systematically and efficiently organise office hours
- how to encourage passive and insecure students to actively participate in the guiding process

The workshop consists of three parts: (1) online-meeting for 4 AE, (2) application phase for 1 AE, (3) online-meeting for 3 AE. During the application phase you will either develop a preparatory questionnaire or a protocol template for your office hour.
