

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION FOR SUMMER SEMESTER 2026 PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY!

→ Enrollment deadline and procedure

Enrollment period: 1 February to 23 April 2026. The enrollment will be possible until 23 April, but please try to complete your enrollment by 31 March so that you can take part in the orientation phase and avoid problems with course registration. An extension of the deadline for enrolment won't be possible!

Orientation for new students: 06 April to 10 April 2026

Start of lecture period: 13 April 2026

- o In order to enrol, please pay the semester fees and send the complete set of documents listed on the acceptance letter in PDF format by e-mail to: jo.registration@zv.upb.de. The university needs to receive an electronic notification from a German statutory health insurance provider stating that you fulfil the legal requirements for enrollment at a German university! Please check the information provided by the university on student health insurance!

→ Semester fees and payment procedure

- Please transfer the compulsory administrative fees of €325.50 for student services and the semester ticket for public transportation to the bank account of Paderborn University.
- To avoiding administrative difficulties, the exact amount requested has to be transferred to the account of Paderborn University, stating your matriculation number (see subject line of acceptance letter).
- For administrative reasons, don't transfer the fees before 1 February 2026; the payment has to be transferred to the university account until 23 April 2026 at the latest.
